LEGISLATION

Letter to President Trump demanding reinstatement of NLRB Member Gwynn Wilcox

Working people supported this letter to President Trump protesting his firing of National Labor Relations Board Member Gwynn Wilcox.

H.R. 77 – Midnight Rules Relief Act

Working people opposed this bill that would allow the federal government to overturn worker protections without input from the public.

H.R. 1526 – No Rogue Ruling Act (“NORRA”)

Working people opposed this bill that would restrict restitution and legal access for federal workers who were unlawfully fired.

H.Con.Res.14 – House Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Resolution

Working people opposed this budget bill that would cut funding for critical services that hardworking taxpayers depend upon.

H.R. 22 – The Safeguard American Voter Eligibility (SAVE) Act

Working people opposed this bill that would create duplicative and burdensome barriers for Americans to access their constitutional right to vote.

H.R. 1 – One Big Beautiful Bill Act

Working people opposed this bill that would enact devastating cuts to Medicaid, SNAP, and other important social safety programs to provide tax-cuts to the rich.

H.R. 4 – Rescissions Act of 2025

Working people opposed this bill that would gut foreign assistance programs and eliminating all federal support for public broadcasting.

H.R. 1 – One Big Beautiful Bill Act, Cruz Amendment

Working people opposed this amendment that would ban State and local laws that protect their communities from the dangers of unsafe and unethical use of artificial intelligence (AI).

H.R. 3633 – Digital Asset Market Clarity Act of 2025

Working people opposed this bill that would enable the crypto industry to operate without effective oversight and endanger hard-earned retirement benefits.

H.Res. 936 – Rule for National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2026

Working people opposed this rule that fails to restore collective bargaining rights for federal workers at the Department of Defense after this provision was originally included in the underlying legislation.

H.R. 2550 – Protecting America’s Workforce Act

Working people supported this bill that restores the collective bargaining rights of over a million federal workers.

H.R. 6703 – Lower Health Care Premiums for All Americans Act

Working people opposed this bill because it promoted substandard health coverage for working families as a substitute for Affordable Care Act tax credits that would have cut premium costs in half for 20 million Americans.

LEGISLATION

Letter to President Trump demanding reinstatement of NLRB Member Gwynn Wilcox

Working people supported this letter to President Trump protesting his firing of National Labor Relations Board Member Gwynn Wilcox.

H.R. 1968 – Full-Year Continuing Appropriations and Extensions Act

Working people opposed this bill/budget that would cut funding for critical services that hardworking taxpayers depend upon.

S.Con.Res.7 – Senate 2025 Budget Resolution

Working people opposed this resolution that would initiate a process to cut trillions in taxes for the wealthy and large corporations with little benefit to working families.

S.J.Res.37 – A Joint Resolution Terminating the National Emergency Declared to Impose Duties on Articles Imported from Canada

Working people supported this bill that terminates the across the board use of tariffs against our allies and trade partners rather than strategic deployment of these trade tools where necessary.

S.1582 – GENIUS Act

Working people opposed this bill that would enable the crypto industry to operate without effective oversight and endanger hard-earned retirement benefits.

H.R. 1 – One Big Beautiful Bill Act

Working people opposed this bill that would enact devastating cuts to Medicaid, SNAP, and other important social safety programs to provide tax-cuts to the rich.

Nomination of Emil Bove

Working people opposed the confirmation of Emil Bove to the Third Circuit U.S. Court of Appeals.

S. 3386 – Health Care Freedom for Patients Act

Working people opposed this bill that would not prevent catastrophic increases to health care premium prices that will deny access to millions of American families.

S. 3385 – Lower Health Care Costs Act

Working people supported this bill that would provide a clean, three-year extension to Affordable Care Act subsidies to prevent extreme increases in premium prices for American consumers.
